Just a reminder, if you are preparing a basket for the raffle, they are due on August 15th and should be wrapped in cellophane and include a list of contents.

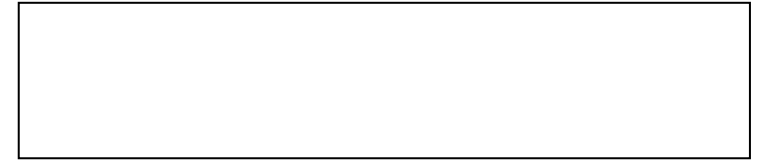
