There will be two opportunities to greet the family with calling times at St. John's on both Thursday evening, August 11<sup>th</sup>, from 6-8pm, and then again before the service from 9-10:30am on Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup>. The service to celebrate Sue's life will take place on Friday August 12<sup>th</sup> at 11am in the sanctuary at St. John's. Be mindful that, beloved as Sue was, the crowd gathering at church will be quite large. Please plan accordingly and offer grace to the family who will do their best to greet as many people as possible while also attending to their own needs of the day.

My friends, hope in God's promises is what sustained Rev. Sue until the end and what she gracefully and faithfully stepped into as she left us this morning. It is that same hope and those same promises that we cling to now, knowing that we do not do so alone and, as Rev. Sue always said, "trusting that God has hands large enough and strong enough to hold each one of us." May it be so as we grieve and remember.
