Roots and Shoots!

During this summer season we will be focusing on the great narrative of our *spiritual ancestors* found in the first book of the Bible, the book of Genesis (chapters 12-45). There are various ways to think about the structure of the book of Genesis, but one very compelling way is to think about it as the story of God "calling" into being the "world" (chapters 1-11) and then God calling a special people (chapters 12-50) "Israel."* These two momentous events, the calling of the world into being, and the calling of a people into being means that both the world and this special people were created and called for a purpose, a vocation. As the book of Genesis begins, we learn that creation has a divine purpose. There is also a divine purpose for God's people as we come to understand that Abraham and his offspring are to become blessings to the world. Our community of faith now stands in that long line of servants who seek to love and serve the world that God so loves. Abraham (meaning "father of a multitude") is our spiritual ancestor, but he is also the spiritual ancestor of our Jewish and Islamic brothers, sisters. and siblings. And so, Abraham is a source of unity among Jews, Christians, and Muslims.

*This helpful analysis and emphasis on the idea of "call" comes from Biblical scholar Walter Brueggemann.
